YOU WILL NEED:

ASSORTED PIECES OF GLASS.

PICK UP AS MUCH COLORED GLASS AS YOU CAN FIND FROM THRIFT SHOPS, DOLLAR STORES HOME GOODS ETC.

IF YOU LIKE, YOU CAN PAINT PLAIN CLEAR PIECES WITH GLASS PAINT. I AM NOT SURE HOW WELL THEY WOULD STAND UP TO WEATHER THOUGH.

EACH PIECE WILL BE ONE LAYER OF THE FLOWER.

VOTIVES AND SMALL SALTS ETC MAKE GOOD CENTERS.

COLORED GLASS IS HARDER TO FIND BUT KEEP REVISITING THRIFT SHOPS THEY RESTOCK CONSTANTLY.

GLASS MARBLES/BEADS TO DECORATE EACH FLOWER IF YOU LIKE. I EVEN FOUND SOME GLASS BUGS AT A BEAD SHOP!

E6000 SILICONE GLUE CLEAR ONE TUBE WILL DO SEVERAL FLOWERS.

DIRECTIONS:

1) **WASH** ALL THE PIECES IN SOAP AND WATER. AFTER DRYING, WIPE LIGHTLY WITH ALCOHOL TO REMOVE ANY RESIDUE.

THIS IS IMPORTANT IF YOU ARE GOING TO PAINT ANY PIECES.

2) **THE FUN PART!** CHOOSE THE PIECES YOU'D LIKE TO LAYER, UNTIL YOU GET THE BEST COMBINATION. IT TAKES THREE OR FOUR LAYERS TO MAKE A FLOWER. THE LARGEST ONE WILL BE THE BACK.
